Key Decisions Summary – CC27

- CC26 Minutes approved:
 - CC26(2) summary overview on Organizational Culture to be a reference point for next steps in continuing to optimize Council engagement and culture
- Operation: Adoption targets are on schedule to meet 2022 Target (8,000) based on trend analysis from previous years
 - Increasing number of brands accepting SLCP data (63)
 - O New collaboration agreement underway with Fair Wear Foundation
- Finance: Strong overall financial position based on 2022 progress:
- CC28 agenda items (see initial building blocks sent as pre-read): possible case for more focus on fewer/strategic topics, allowing less important/more routine items to be dealt with via a separate online meeting (or on day 3 AM)
- SAC/ SLCP relationship and separation:
 - Joint Working Group (JWG) being reset with changes in representation on both sides:
 SLCP (now Steve, Anna, Janet) and SAC (now Tamar, Pascal and Wendy)

3. Progress (Operational) Updates

Context/ Discussion

- CAF Adoption and Updates
 - So far, 2519 VRF in 2022 (31% of the 2022 Target 8,000 VRFs). We are on schedule, based on seasonal uptake trend from previous years
 - Expecting peak in Q3, will need to continue to monitor Verifier / Verifier Body availability
- SLCP Acceptance and Convergence

- o 63 brands on acceptance list
 - Note that some brands are using the CAF, but do not (yet) appear on our Acceptance list (e.g. brands/retailers that require vFSLM on tier 1 suppliers),
- o New collaboration agreement underway with Fair Wear Foundation (FWF)
 - FWF to work with brands to develop a tool/template for using SLCP verified assessments for remediation actions
 - FWF to develop HR Due Diligence framework based on aggregated SLCP data insights.
- SLCP is an impact partner with Global Fashion Agenda (GFA) Janet (ED) spoke on a panel at the GFA conference in June and SLCP received coverage in their annual 'Monitor' report

- To help rebooting, a proposed change of SLCP representation within a re-composed.
- General availability due to summer has resulted in no meeting occurring until late August
- To keep this moving, an initial proposed reset/refocus on the JWG (July 2022)

Discussion

- Three critical items (legal status of new entity, IP and timing of the separation) to hopefully be addressed in re-composed JWG
- Joint build-out is as important as possible in moving away from the previous stumbling blocks of it being a SLCP proposal without SAC ownership
- Chair-to-Chair periodic calls to develop their relationship and leverage this to support future negotiations
- Elements of the previous Shared Principles/Collaboration document can still be used in the JWG process
