Progress Updates – 5 Year Strategy Development

- Work with The Terrace has kicked off. A consultant has also been recruited for the horizon scanning (commencing shortly).
- The Council Strategy Committee is working alongside Secretariat and The Terrace on

strategy development and signatory engagement

• The main opportunity for in-person consultation with signatories (plus the whole Council) will be around the June Global Fashion Agenda event in Copenhagen. This will be supplemented with online meetings and surveys.

SAC/SLCP Relationship & Separation

- The Joint Working Group (JWG) has made significant progress since the adoption of the North Star by the SAC Board and SLCP Council. Keeping in mind the best interests of workers and of the industry as a whole has been a helpful and consistent guiding principle in navigating some complex and, at times, challenging discussions.
- The key points of progress so far were captured in the pre-read memo provided to the SLCP Council, which mirrors a similar memo to the SAC Board for their approval on March 15th, and which reflects the JWG's shared positivity and passion about SLCP's future direction. These include:
 - SLCP will establish itself as a 'stichting' in the Netherlands (non-profit)
 - The JWG's preferred option is for IP and other assets to be transferred to the SLCP's new entity at no cost
 - There will be close strategic partnership between SAC and SLCP's new entity.
 - There will be a joint comms campaign to acknowledge SAC's role in incubating SLCP
- Once we have clarity on the SAC Board outcome, the JWG will make further progress on the Term Sheet. The SLCP Council will be updated on progress at the CC32 (May), and will have ultimate formal approval of the term sheet (alongside the SAC Board)
- A signatory vote will also be required at some point, with sufficient prior engagement and education of signatories to help ensure a positive vote
- <u>Approval</u>: SLCP Council members approve Memo on the direction of travel from the JWG SAC-SLCP separation progress.
